


From Sorède to the Roc de les Medes



- 1. Exit the tourist office, turn left, and then go straight until you reach the footbridge that you need to cross.
- 2. At the statue of Christ, turn left towards Notre-Dame du Château, passing through the casot circuit. Don't hesitate to take a small detour to see them when they are off the path.
- 3. Turn left onto the track leading to the Ermitage Notre-Dame du Château. Then head towards the Roc de les Medes.
- 4. Admire the view of the Massane and the ruins of Ultrera. Continue along the path, following the yellow markers.
