## **Trek**

Departure : Port-Vendres Train Station Arrival : Port-Vendres Train Station

From in front of the train station, head to the left.

- 1. Turn right onto the strategic road.
- 2. Before reaching the white cross, turn left onto the Mala Cara path. Admire Fort Saint-Elme and enjoy the view of Collioure.
- 3. At this point, after crossing the railway, head back towards the Port-Vendres train station.
- 4. Turn left onto Chemin du Val de Pinte, following the river.


